West Coast is the first company to develop Plastic Free Barrier Coated Paper Board 'Wesco Prime Super Green' to replace the Plastic (PE) Coated Paper used for manufacturing paper cups, plates etc. This is a major step forward in its efforts to reduce the use of plastics. The step will bring down the load of plastics on the environment.

Further, the company has held meetings with the manufacturers of paper cups in Tamil Nadu and Kerala at Coimbatore to create awareness regarding Plastic free Coated Paper Board developed by the company.

Felicitation to Recovery Team for Process Upgradation.

A felicitation was held on 11th January 2020 to Recovery team for successfully finding the root cause of adulteration in Furnace oil in Rotary lime Klin (RLK) using systematic problem solving tools-DMAIC (DEFINE-MEASURE – ANALYSE-IMPORVE- CONTROL) which resulted in savings of around 6 crores a year and also for stabilizing the process with minimal wastage involved.

As a part of problem solving the problem was well defined from the initial stage itself and was solved till the root cause was eliminated. The team believed that a problem well-stated is half-solved. There were some obstacles in this process, but the team never left the hope. It came back with different alternatives to achieve the target condition.

They were satisfied with the working of the plant from the point of view of the steps taken to address the environmental issues.








Workshop conducted by Environment Officer, Dr. Laxmi Kantha, Regional Office, KSPCB, Karwar
